We celebrated Rise AAPI Day at the Capitol. I was privileged to speak to those who came to celebrate AAPI diversity in Texas and the Texas Legislature. We presented a resolution honoring January 30, 2023 as Rise AAPI Day at the Capitol. Forums and discussions were held on policy issues. Many people came in to see us at the office and we are grateful for your engagement.

Members of the legislature and their staffs traveled to the Rio Grande Valley to learn about unique challenges that face the RGV. We spoke with doctors and hospitals, energy and agricultural leaders and with State of Texas officials about border and trade issues with Mexico. As a legislator it is important for me to stay informed about the needs of each part of the state.
