For several reasons, including the need to provide the highest level of transparency for the people of Texas, the House Board of Managers is releasing additional evidence related to the impeachment of Attorney General Ken Paxton. This information was accumulated during the Board's investigation and preparation for trial and is relevant in providing Texans with a complete look at all facts in full context.

This information was not shared or was limited in scope during the impeachment trial for the following reasons:

- time limits for the prosecution's presentation of witnesses and evidence,
- issues with timely responses and (in some cases) noncompliance with subpoenas used for evidence-gathering purposes,
- witnesses choosing to plead the Fifth Amendment (including Ken Paxton, Nate Paul, Laura Olson, Nashimha Raju Sagiraju (known as Raj Kumar), and Kevin Wood), and
- multiple procedural decisions made during the course of the impeachment trial.

The House Board of Managers maintains that overwhelming and uncontroverted testimony and evidence was presented during the impeachment trial in support of the Articles of Impeachment against Attorney General Ken Paxton. The information now shared publicly with this letter provides a clearer foundation for that.
