Capitol Office COVID-19 Safety Protocols

Designed with the knowledge that no one practice can completely eliminate the risk of COVID-19, these protocols layer protective behavior together to allow our office to function in person throughout the 87th Legislative Session.

General Health and Safety Protocols

- ★ Visitors will need an appointment to enter the office. Constituents of HD 108 do not need an appointment.
- ★ To schedule an appointment please call (512) 463-0367.
- ★ Temperature checks with a non-contact forehead thermometer will be conducted upon entry. Visitors with fevers equal to or higher than 100.4°F will be asked to leave and to make arrangements for a virtual meeting or reschedule until symptoms subside.
- ★ Visitors are required to wear their mask over their mouth and nose while in the office.
- ★ Default meeting process will be virtual. Staff will determine if meeting in person is necessary.
- ★ Hand sanitizer will be available near the drop off area. Visitors are encouraged to use hand sanitizer upon arrival to the office.
- ★ Visitors will maintain 6 feet of social distancing from any staff/member.

Cleaning Procedures

- ★ High touch areas will be wiped down with sanitization products throughout the day.
- ★ The Puradigm air and surface purification system will remain on 24/7 in the office.
