BUDGET PASSES THE HOUSE

Just before dawn last Wednesday, after almost 18 hours of debate, the House passed the budget ([HB1](#)) for the next two years, the 2016-2017 biennium. The budget stays below the constitutional spending limit, keeps overall growth at about 4% (approximately 2% each year), and does not spend any of the projected \$11 billion balance in the Rainy Day Fund. The current budget addresses a number of needs for our growing state - including education, transportation, border security and still leaves room for record-setting tax relief.

The process is far from over, however. Next, the House and Senate will confer in conference committee to reconcile the versions of the budget from each respective chamber. Following that reconciliation, it will be placed for a vote, up or down with no amendments, separately by both the House and the Senate. It then makes its way to the Governor's desk for final approval or veto.
