Greetings!

The Texas House of Representatives adjourned three days ago, but as I am sure you have heard, the Governor immediately called the legislature back into special session. So far, the Governor has placed three topics on the agenda: school finance, Medicaid reform, and congressional redistricting.

The main impetus for the special session was the Senate's failure to pass a school finance bill by the end of the regular session. Attached to the school finance bill were several cost saving measures that we needed to pass in order for the Comptroller to certify that our state budget did not spend more than Texas plans to take in over the next two years. Frankly, I am disappointed that a few members of the Senate derailed the process and forced another session that will cost you, the taxpayers, additional money.

By law, a special session cannot last more than thirty days, and during that time, the legislature is only allowed to consider items that the Governor places on the agenda. As always, please call or email with your input on the issues under consideration.

Over the next month or so, I plan to send out several emails reporting on the work of the 82nd legislature. I also plan to hold a town hall meeting in each of the communities within the 101st district. The schedule is below.
