#### **Tax Rate Increases**

#### **Harris County Proposed Historic Tax Rate Hike**

On September 12th, Harris County Commissioner's Court voted to propose the maximum allowable increase of eight percent (8%) to Harris County's tax rate for next year.

This historic increase comes just ahead of a law passed during the 86th Session that would cap such massive increases at three and a half percent (3.5%) before requiring voter approval.

The issue will have had public hearings in September and the final hearing will be in
