Dear Friends,

The last two weeks have been a rollercoaster for Redistricting in our state. On Monday, Texas Attorney General Greg Abbott released three maps (Congressional, Texas House and Senate) that were part of a settlement. The San Antonio court then instructed the parties to keep working because they do not feel that the maps have adequate buy-in from all parties for an agreement. If the maps had been approved on Monday, we would have been able to have a primary on April 3. It is my hope that we come to a resolution soon so we can schedule a primary this Spring.

Please visit the Texas Redistricting website to stay up to date on the court cases and maps. You can even see the new maps to see what our district looks like. Click on District Viewer to view the House, Senate and Congressional maps. We will keep you updated as we hear of any developments.
