### Birth Certificates for Back to School Registration

The Harris County Clerk's office provides a short-form birth certificate that is acceptable for school enrollment. Their office will open on two consecutive Saturdays to provide birth certificates for families who need their child's records for back to school registration.

- Saturday, August 7, 10 a.m.–2 p.m. at 201 Caroline St. (Downtown Office)
- Saturday, August 14, 10 a.m.-2 p.m. at 6000 Chimney Rock Rd. (Chimney Rock Annex)

#### The following are required to apply for a birth certificate:



- Must have been born in the State of Texas
- You must be the person named on the certificate, the legal representative or immediate family member with appropriate identification (ID).
- Have acceptable ID:
- Valid photo ID, such as U.S. Driver's License,
   Federal or State ID card, Military ID, or U.S.
   Passport
- o For other acceptable ID options, visit: Obtaining a Birth Certificate in Texas (state.tx.us).
- A completed birth certificate application
- Payment of \$23.00 (cash or credit card)





#### **COVID-19 Vaccine Information**

With the Delta variant, vaccination is more urgent than ever. Data shows that the Delta variant is different than past versions of the virus: it is much more contagious and people with breakthrough infections may spread it - even those who have been vaccinated.

- Since COVID-19 vaccination began, nearly all Texas COVID-19 deaths are among people who are not fully vaccinated.
- Like any vaccine, COVID-19 vaccines cannot stop 100% of infections, but they do protect most people.
- While rare, breakthrough cases where fully vaccinated people get COVID-19 are expected, but fully vaccinated people are much less likely to get seriously sick.
- Full vaccination is the best defense against COVID-19 and its variants.
- Wearing a mask in indoor pubic settings, regardless of vaccination status, helps protect you and everyone close to you.
- CDC recommends universal indoor masking for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors to K-12 schools, regardless of vaccination status.

Getting vaccinated is FREE and does not require ID, proof of residency, citizenship, or insurance.

**People age 12 and older are eligible for COVID-19 vaccination.** Houston Health Department-affiliated vaccination sites are located across the city for walk-ins or appointments. Find nearby sites below or call 832-393-4220 for assistance.




#### METRO Gulfton Circulator

We are proud to announce that Houston METRO will be implementing a new route this month in the Gulfton area linking multiple destinations with the Bellaire Transit Center, Hillcroft Park & Ride, and the Westpark/Lower Uptown Transit Center.

Starting Sunday, August 22, the **309 Gulfton Circulator** will operate 7 days a week to better serve Houston's most densely populated neighborhood. Please see the map below for more details on the route and stops. Buses will operate in both directions of the circulation route simultaneously.

The **309 Gulfton Circulator** will expand connectivity to existing METRO routes serving the area and offer greater connections to transit centers, as well as important neighborhood stops such as schools, groceries, laundry, and shopping.
