


House District 1 - Bowie, Franklin, Lamar & Red River counties District & Capitol Report 85th Legislature - February 2017



Around the District.

Proscribed burns to be conducted between March & June 2017. The Texas Parks & Wildlife Department (TPWD) recently informed my office that it will conduct one or more prescribed burns in the Pat Mayse Wildlife Management Area between March and June 2017 in an area at the intersection of County roads 3565 and 3561. Neighboring landowners have been notified and a notice will be published in

education that has been meeting frequently to hear information from a wide range of state agencies including the Texas Education Agency, Teacher Retirement System of Texas, Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and all of the state's public colleges and universities and their service agencies. Though lengthy, these hearings are an excellent chance to really learn about our state's diverse educational operations from pre-K classes to the highest level of research being conducted at our elite research universities.

Additionally, I have been selected to serve on the oversight board for the Texas House Research Organization (HRO), which is a nonpartisan independent department of the House of Representatives that provides impartial information on legislation and issues before the Texas Legislature.

Committees are hearing presentations from agencies and experts and will soon begin hearing bills. If you are looking to follow a certain piece of legislation, you can use the Texas Legislature Online website at http://www.legis.texas.gov/ to get access to a bill's status in the legislative process, as well as authors, coauthors, and Senate companion bills.
