



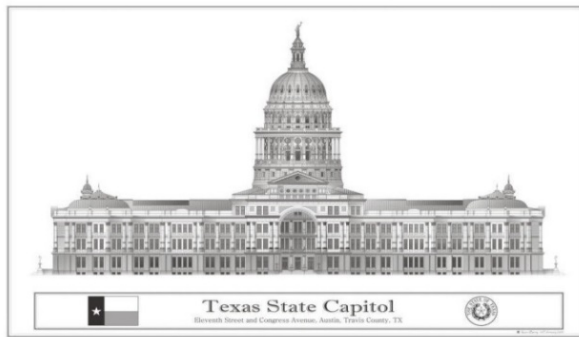

Voter registration deadline nearing. Tuesday, October 9, is the deadline to be registered to vote for the upcoming November 6, general election.
