Constitutional Amendment Propositions For the November 5th Ballot

The 2019 Constitutional Amendment Propositions all passed by a wide margin, except for proposition number one, which provided for elected municipal judges to be elected in more than one city at a time. The measure was proposed to assist rural municipalities that have difficulty finding qualified candidates to serve as municipal judge. The voters were not convinced it was necessary and defeated the measure. In Harris County alone, the measure failed by over 68%.

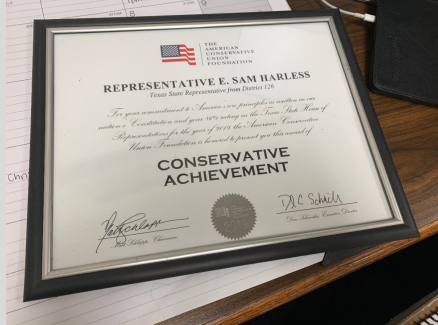

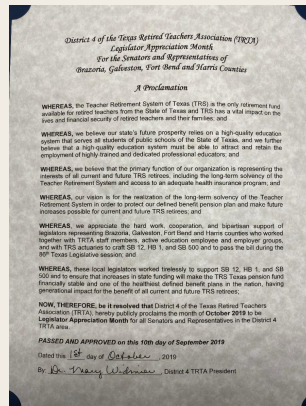
The American Conservative Union Foundation

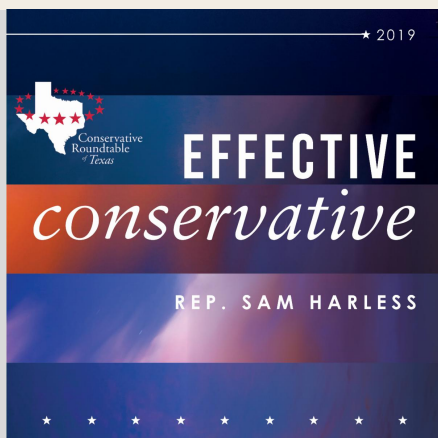
District 4 of Texas Retired Teachers Association
