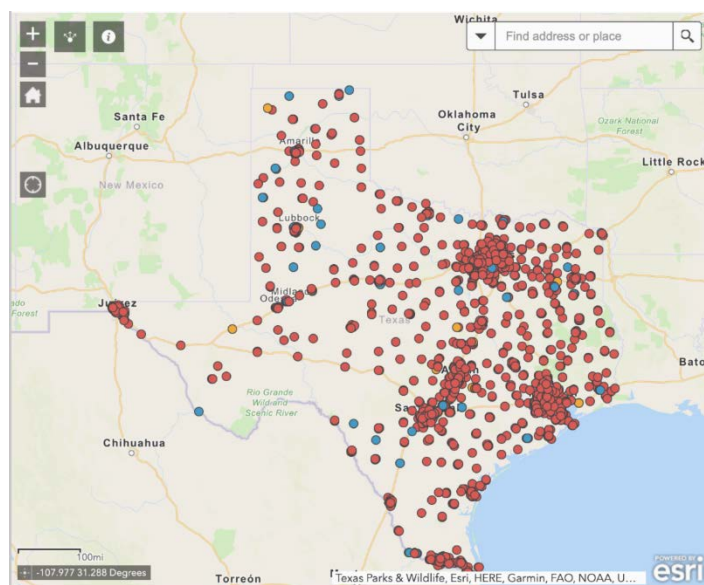
As we round out the second week of March, I would like to bring you up to speed on things in the Texas House.
