OVERVIEW

The Office of State Representative Gina Hinojosa seeks a professional and motivated Communications Intern. As a Communications Intern for Rep. Hinojosa, you will primarily create content and assist senior staff with the management of Rep. Hinojosa's social media platforms. This position will report directly to the District Director, but the candidate will work closely with all members of the office. The position will take place primarily in person during the Spring Semester (starting as soon as possible and continuing until at least until the end of May) and requires a time commitment of 10 hours per week (part-time). There is the potential for this position to continue into the Summer and Fall.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Photographing and filming content for social media
- Researching social media trends and development of ideas for content creation
- Developing proposed copy for social media posts, newsletters, and other communications
- Creating videos for social media that represent the personality of Rep. Hinojosa and District 49
- Other duties as assigned by the member and staff

- Passion for issues and policies supported by Rep. Hinojosa, such as quality public education, environmental justice, voting rights, healthcare access, and workforce development.
- Ability to meet tight deadlines, sometimes with very little notice
- Self-starter, with the ability to work well in a team seating

- Ability to communicate with professionalism, clarity, and timeliness with the offices of other elected officials, constituents, and others who engage with the office
- Strong planning and organizational skills, with keen attention to detail
